How to Sleep in the Same Bed With Dogs

Instructions

- Step 1:
Monitor your dogs' temperaments. Assertive, territorial or untrained dogs should not be allowed to sleep on your [bed](#), according to the Veterinary Partner website. This kind of dog will think it is higher on the "food chain" than you if allowed to sleep on the bed. This can lead to other problems, such as not obeying your commands.
- Step 2:
Set up boundaries. Allocate a spot on your bed where your pets are allowed to sleep. Come up with a command such as "spot" that tells your dogs to go to that spot. Repeat this command when telling your dogs to go to this spot. Whether it's the foot or the left side of the bed, make sure that any time the pets are on the bed, that's where they rest or sleep.
- Step 3:
Practice your exit strategy. When it's time to get up or you want your dogs off the bed, first tell them to get off the bed using a command such as "off" and then put on their leashes and remove them from the bed. After some conditioning, most dogs will start to get off the bed on the first command, without having to be leashed.




